Subject:	Cable boxes

Homeowners,

As you have been informed by the cable company, they are planning to switch to an all digital signal soon. The change is set to take place in mid March and you will need a digital cable box in order to continue to receive the signal. Cableone has issued these boxes to the HOA and each homeowner is entitled to receive 2 boxes at no charge. You may obtain the boxes from our board president Max Baldwin in unit 84 and will need to sign a form for the box number for each box you pick up. You can contact Max by calling him at 228-669-6840. You can email Max at <u>maxbaldwin@cableone.net</u>.

These boxes issued to the HOA are the only boxes we will receive so if in the future you need additional boxes you will have to deal will Cableone in order to obtain them. It is my understanding that anybody needing a replacement digital box will have to pay \$5 per month. Those of you who lease their units should take measures to see that tenants do not take the boxes when they leave your unit. We will not issue these boxes to tenant residents without written homeowner approval so if you wish to have your tenant obtain the box for you, you will need to provide written consent for them to do so. If a tenant wishes to receive a cable box they must present a letter from you authorizing them to do so.

Boxes are not needed where you already have a cableone box, please refer to cableone.com for more info on this subject and for box installation diagrams if you need assistance. Cableone employees will not install your digital box without a charge to you.

The HOA has a contract with Cableone through 2019 to provide basic cable service to all residents of Anatole Bay, so even if you have another TV provider at this time, you should still obtain these devices now in case you choose to revert to cable service in the future.
